- **Maturity & Poise:** Comfortable in front of people, able to handle pressure and anxiety well. Gets along well with others/good team player.
- **Responsibility:** Have complete and detailed responses to the judge's questions. Application filled out completely and neatly. Sponsor secured and details taken care of.
- **Parental Support:** Parent and family support is strongly encouraged for maximum success and enjoyment of the ambassador.
- **Communication:** As a candidate and if chosen as an ambassador communication is extremely important. It is imperative that you communicate with chaperones.
- **Vocabulary:** When speaking you should use correct grammar and complete sentences. You should not use any form of slang.
- **Speech:** Clear projected voice, pacing is important, tone and quality of voice.
